Joined the Skiffle and Blues Band „Inga Lynch & Wanted Men from 2006-2012.

1st Solo Album „Stella , Mono Recordings“, released 2013, with guitarist and producer Frank Schwinn.

Song „Enjoy the Ride“ from the first album got featured in the HBO documentary „Paycheck by Paycheck“ in 2013.

2nd Album „Tossed and Turned“ , recorded with various musicians in Austria and USA, released in 2015.
